# Professional transition project (PTP)



**The professional transition project (PTP) allows every employee to use the payments registered on his CPF (personal training account) account in order to fund an aggregated training action with the goal of changing trades or occupations.**

**During the leave granted for this training, the employee is compensated, and his teaching and additional costs are taken care of.**

## Good to know

All trainings compensated through the PTP can be partially cumulated with AREs for all reviews relating to an end of contract on November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 at the earliest.

- Hours and wages paid through the PTP can be taken into account for the review of the benefits claim.
- The two-thirds of affiliation limit does not apply.

**All hours spent on a PTP training are accounted for on the condition that the PTP is granted for activities relating to the casual show-business sector.**

## Warning

- You must forward a wage slip to France Travail on a monthly basis, and an employer's declaration upon the end of your training.
- The job mentioned on the wage slips and on the declaration will determine whether the PTP training relates to annexes 8/10 or to the general scheme.
- The professional transition association must pay the specific contribution to the France Travail recovery centre for show-business employers.

## Updating

- The monthly update is mandatory. Hours and wages paid through the PTP must be declared as a paid activity.
- Question "Are you in training", answer "No".
