My art and technical teaching hours



The hours corresponding to art and technical classes given by technicians or artists are taken into account under certain conditions.

That will allow you to verify the 507 worked hours required to open an entitlement to showbusiness benefits.

1. Amount of hours

- A maximum of 70 hours for workers younger than 50
- · A maximum of 120 hours for 50 years old workers and above

Please note: the exact age taken into account is the one at the end of the contract considered for the opening of the entitlement.

2. Type of hours

Teaching hours must be related to the practiced artistic or technical profession. For example, language courses given by an artist will not be taken into account.

3. Type of structure

Teaching hours will only be taken into account for the processing of the 507 worked hours if they are exercised in approved institutions.

4. Conditions

- · Hours must be declared and verified.
- From your personal France Travail account, you must forward: your work contract, and then your monthly wage slips.
- For contracts signed with publically-funded private or public structures, you must forward either of the following:
 - → Certification of grant aid, or
 - → Certification issued by the employer declaring a grant aid and covering the relevant time period.

5. One specific detail for technicians

For technicians, the teaching contract must have ended by the time the benefits claim is reviewed.

6. Good to know!

- Hours and wages are not taken into account for the calculation of the amount of the daily allowance.
- It is possible to cumulate training hours and teaching hours. Said accumulation cannot go above two-thirds of the required affiliation (338 hours for the ARE)
